

Guidelines for Establishing a Covenant Partnership With a Cuban Church

Purpose of a Partnership Covenant:

Establishing a *Partnership Covenant* with a Cuban church is for the purpose of:

1. Evangelism and leadership training
2. Development and implementation of an evangelistic strategy
3. Support and assistance in finances and material resources
4. Encouragement of pastor, his family and church members
5. Assist with the "Bibles for Cuba" project (placement of a N.T. in the hand of every person in Cuba.)

Expectations of a Partner Church

The U.S. Partner Church agrees to endeavor to do the following for a five year partnership:

1. Make an initial visit to the church to establish a personal relationship with the pastor, his family and the church members.
2. Discuss with the Cuban pastor to identify ways your church can assist consistent with the five purposes of the Covenant Partnership.
3. Take a mission team to work at the Cuban church at least once per year.
4. Correspond regularly via email or air mail with the church pastor
5. Faithfully pray for the Cuban church its ministry and the "Bible for Cuba" project

Steps in Establishing a Partnership Covenant

To establish a Covenant Partnership with a Cuban church the following steps should be followed:

1. Prayerfully discern God's leading in making a five year partnership commitment.
2. Complete the Cuban Partnership Covenant Form on www.acts169.org
3. Make arrangements to travel with MCM to Cuba
